WAIVER OF OBLIGATION UNDER BOND.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, whereas, on the 6th day of March 1908, the Secretary of the Interior approved an oil and gas mining lease on the allotment of Elmira Morgan said allotment embracing the following described lands:

Lot 2 less 3.77 acres K.O.G. & S R R right of way and South west 10 acres of Lot 1, of Sec. 6, T.21 R. 14 E. said lease being dated July 27, 1907. *and made by Elmira Morgan* in favor of Duquense Oil and Gas Company, a corporation, and,

WHEREAS, the said Duquense Oil and Gas Company made and executed a bond to the United States of America in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15000.00) conditioned upon the said Duquense Oil and Gas Company's faithfully performing all the obligations and conditions of the aforesaid lease and observing all the laws of the United States and regulations thereunder made by the Secretary of the Interior; and.

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Interior has been relieved by Act of Congress of May 27, 1906, of all fur her jurisdiction of said premises and said lease and is desirous of being relieved of any and all obligations and duties assumed under said bond; and

WHEREAS, the said Elmira Morgan has transferred all her right title and interest in and to said land to James D. Ward, said transfer having been made on the 5th day of January 1909

NOW THEREFORE, James D. Ward, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby relieve and release the United States of America from all further obligations and duties under said lease to Duquense Oil and Gas Company and under said bond made by the United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company, as surety and

DO HEREBY SUBSTITUTE for the United States Indian Agent, Union Agency, Muskogee, Oklahoma, the Farmers and Merchants Bank of Collinsville, Oklahoma, as a place of payment of the rentals and royalties under said lease do hereby authorize the lessee and his assigns to pay all rentals and royalties falling due under said lease at the said Farmers and Merchants Bank, of Collinsville, Oklahoma, to the owner of the said land, and to hereby agree that all advance royalty and rental payable for the delay of operations, may be made in quarterly payments in advance the first quarterly payment of advance royalty, and rental payable for the delay of operations, to be due at each quarter period from the date to which said advance royalty, and rental payable for the delay of operations is paid.
