ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

This instrument made and entered into this 26th day of May, 1910, by and between B.H. McCoy of Tulsa, Oklahoma, first party, and H. Kerstetter, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, second party, WITNESSETH:

That whereas, on the 4th day of October, 1909, Melissa Thomas, as guardian of Joseph Perryman and Ralph Perryman, minors, executed and delivered to the Daisy Bell Oil company, a corporation, a certain oil and gas mining lease covering the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 18 North, range, 12 East of the Indian Base and Meridian; and

Whereas, the Daisy Bell Oil Company has by an instrument of writing dated the 20th day of April, 1910, agreed to transfer and assign unto the first party an undivided $\frac{5}{16}$ interest in and to the aforesaid oil and gas lease and the leasehold estate thereby created upon certain conditions therein set forth and

Wherease, the said Daisy Bell Oil Company has by an instrument of writing of date April 22, 1910, which has been deposited in escrow at the Exchange National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, to be delivered to the first party upon the happening of the conditions therein set forth, transferred, assigned conveyed unto the first party an undivided $\frac{5}{16}$ interest in and to the aforesaid oil and gas lease and the leasehold estate thereby created.

NOW THEREFORE for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar cash in hand paid, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said first party hereby sells, assigns, transfers and conveys unto the second party an undivided $\frac{1}{8}$ interest in and to the aforesaid oil and gas lease and the leasehold estate thereby created.

To have and to hold the said undivided $\frac{1}{8}$ interest in and to the said oil and gas lease and the leasehold estate thereby created unto the said H. Kerstetter his heirs and assigns during the full term of said lease, but subject to the provisions and conditions therein contained.
