South half of the South west Quarter of Section Eleven (11) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Eleven (11) East

PROVIDED, that whereas the party of the first part owns a one eighth royalty interest in the oil and gas lying in and under said lands:

NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed between the parties hereto that if the party of the first part desires to sell said one eighth royalty interest in said lands at any time within twelve months after said well is drilled, as aforesaid, that the party of the second part will purchase said royalty interest and pay for the same the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) dollars, upon the execution of proper instruments of conveyance.

AND it is hereby mutually agreed between the parties hereto that party of the first part has and shall retain a lien on the premises herein above described for the payment of said sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) dollars and may subject said premises to the satisfaction of the terms of said contract.

The drilling of said well to the depth herein stated, shall, of itself, with notice, be the date of the commencement of said term of twelve ~~years~~ *months*.
