we the undersigned commissioners appointed by the Hon. L.M. Poe, judge of the District Court in and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to inspect and view the real estate and every part thereof hereinafter described, and to assess the value of said property and the damages which the owners thereof will sustain by the appropriation of hereinafter described land to the uses of School District No. 16, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, do hereby certify that having been duly appointed as commissioners and appraisers as herein set forth on the 12th day of November, 1910, as herein set forth and having taken and subscribed to the oath of commissioners as required by law we did on the 16th day of November, 1910, proceed to said hereinafter described premises and did then and there inspect and view said hereinafter described real estate and every part thereof and did assess the value of said property and the damages which the owners thereof will sustain by the appropriation of said hereinafter described land to the use of School District, No. 16, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, said land being described as follows, to-wit:
