ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That whereas J.I. Gillespie is owner and holder of an undivided one fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) interest in and to a certain oil and gas mining lease on the following described land, to-wit:

The East One Half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the East one Half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) less ten (10) acres out of the Northwest corner of said east one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the southeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) all in section Nine (9), Township Twenty one (21) North, range, Thirteen (13) East Tulsa County, Oklahoma, the same being a part of the allotment of Webster C. Baker, and John H. Baker; and,

Whereas, said J.I. Gillespie hereinafter known as party of the first part is desirous of assigning all his right, title and interest in and to said undivided one fourth interest in said above described lease to S. Rabinovitz hereinafter known as party of the second part, his heirs and assigns;

Now Therefore, said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Twenty two Hundred and fifty dollars (\$2250.00) paid by said party of the second part to said party of the first part, said party of the first part does hereby sell, assign, transfer, set over and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the right, and title in and to the undivided one fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) interest in and to said hereinbefore described oil and gas mining lease heretofore held by said party of the first part;

This assignment is intended to convey and does convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the right, title and interest in and to said hereinbefore described lease heretofore held by said party of the first part and is made subject to the conditions and stipulations contained in said lease and is and shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, executors administrators and assigns.

It is further conditioned that said party of the second part shall bear his proportionate part of the expenses and costs of opening said hereinbefore described lease accruing after the date of this assignment and that all oil run from this lease after the date of this instrument and before a division order is signed, to said J.I. Gillespie shall be credited and set over to said party of the second part, S. Rabinovitz.
