Section 8. Section One of Article 1X of the sub-division "Sidewalks" of the Charter of the City of Tulse, shall be smended by adding thereto the following.

Provided, that upon the maturity of any such assessment for the construction and repair off sidewalks as provided in this section, the Commissioner of Finance and Revenue of the City of Tulss, may certify the amount of such assessment together with accrued interest thereon to the Treasurer of Tulsa County, who shall enter the same upon the delinquent tax rolls of the County of Tulsa, and the collection thereof shall be made by the county Treasurer in the same manner and with the same penalties as is provided by law for the collection of advalorem taxes in the county of Tulsa; provided however, that the same need not be a advertised or sold at the time provided for the sale of property in said county for ad valorem taxes, but may be advertised and sold by the County Treasurer at any time for such taxes, in the same manner in all other respects as is or may be provided by the laws of the state for the collection of delinquent ad valorem taxes; and such assessment, when collected, shall be paid over to the City Treasurer for disbursement, according to law.

Section 9? Section 13 of Article 1X of the Charter to read as follows:

All contracts heretofore entered into by the City of Tulsa or which may hereafter be entered into by the City, and before the provisions of this Charter become effective, and all ordinances made in relation to such contracts shall be given full force an effect under the laws and ordinances in force at the date of the making of such contracts and such improvements shall be carried forward and completed in accordance with such laws and ordinances; and that all costs of such improvement shall be assessed by the Board of Commissioners against the abutting property, owners and other persons, firms or corporations made liable for the payment of such costs under and in accordance with the provisions of the laws and ordinances then in force. The Board of commissioners created and authorized by this Charter are hereby authorized and directed, and it is hereby authorized and directed, and it is hereby made their duty to do and perform or cause to be done or performed, all things which, by such existing laws and ordinances of such city, the City Council of such city and the officers thereof scting thereunder are now authorized or permitted to do, in order to carry anto effect the terms of such contract, and to assess the costs of improvement against such property, and to provide for the collection of such assessment, and to provide for the insurance of assignable certificates therefor, and to do and perform any other act or thing which may be necessary under the said existing laws and ordinances of said city, to give effect to said contracts and to provide for the enforcement thereof. The fact that more than one parcel or lot of land, the property of the owner or jointly owned by two or more persons, firms or corporations, having been assessed together in one assessment shall not invalidate the same, or the lien thereof. The ests of any such improvements assessed against any property, together with all costs and reasonable expenses in collecting the same, including ressorable attorney's fees when incurred, shall be secured by a lien upon such property superior to all other liens, claims or title, excet city, county and state taxes: Upon any installment of the said assessment becoming delinquent under theterms of the ordinance assessing the same it shall hereafter he the duty of the commissioner of Finance and Revenue promptly after the date of the maturity of any such installment of assessment and interest, and on or before the 15th day of September in each year, to certify such installment of assessment and the interest then due to the county Treasurer. of Tulsa County, which installment of assessment and interest shall be by the said County Tresurer placed upon the celinquent tax list of said county for the current year and collected as other delinquent taxes are collected and thereupon paid to the City
