ORDER APPROVING OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE. Probate No. 728.

THIS matter came on to be heard on this the 2nd day of December, 1910, upon the petition of Hollis Collins, Guardian of James Davis, a minor, asking for an order of this Court approving, ratifying, confirming and declaring valid a certain oil and gas mining lease made and executed by him as said Guardian for and on behalf of said minor, and of a certain agreement made and entered into by him as such Guardian relative to the payment of the consideration for said lease, which lease and agreement run to W.C. Guiler, C.E. Deloe, and Homer S. Grosman, and which said lease and agreement have been presented to this Court for approval.

The petitioner appearing in his own proper person and by Robinson & Gore his attorneys, and the court, after hearing the testimony of the petitioner and other witnesses as to the value of the real estate described in the said lease, for oil and gas mining purposes, and in regard to the title to said real estate and the said agreement, for the payment of the consideration for said lease, and being fully advised in the premises finds:-

That the allegations in said petition contained are true; that the said Hollis Collins is the legally appointed, qualified and acting Guardian of said minor that said minor is possessed of the following described real estate situate in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and the N 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and the N 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section Twenty nine (29) Township Eighteen (18) Range Thirteen (13) containing 80 acres more or less.
