and the Grantee, its successors and assigns, shall at all reasonable times have the right of ingress and egress to and from said line or lines for the purposes of construction, inspecting, repairing and maintaining the same and the removal of such at will in whole or in part.

The grantee, its successors and assigns, to select the route of such lines.

To have and to hold the said easements unto the said The Texas Company, its successors and assigns, so long as such structures are maintained.

By acceptance hereof, the grantee covenants for itself, successors and assigns that it will so bury said pipe lines as that such will not interfere with the cultivation of the premises, and also that it will pay all damages to crops, fences and land, which may be suffered from the maintaining and operating of said pipe line.

It is understood that the person securing this right of way in behalf of the Grantee is without authority to make any covenant or agreement in respect to the premises not expressed herein.

RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE SUM OF Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars to the undersigned owners in hand paid by The Texas Company, a corporation of Texas, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Mrs. Thomas Washington do hereby grant to the said The Texas company a corporation, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas, and to erect, maintain, and operate a telegraph or telephone line, with right of ingress and egress to and from both, said right of way being more fully described by plats of definite location approved by the Secretary of the Interior, on, over and through certain lands allotted to Mrs Thos. Washington, a citizen of the Delaware Nation, Roll No. 66, situate in the county of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, and described as follows:

The S 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 22N Range 12 E.

The said grantors, their heirs or assigns are to fully use and enjoy the said premises except the easement for the purposes hereinbefore granted to The Texas Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns.
