

And it appearing to this court that the said John Washington, died intestate in what is now a part of Tulsa County, in the month of May, about the year 1904, and that the said Rosa Watushe is an heir of the said John Washington, a deceased full blood Indian, and said Rosa Watushe, is also a full blood Indian.

And it further appearing to this court that the said Rosa Watushe has for the love and affection, together with the consideration of One Dollar, executed and made a quit claim deed to Emma Cumsey, also an heir of the said John Washington, deceased.

And it further appearing to this court from the testimony of Rosa Watushe, that she is making this quit claim deed for the purpose of conveying any interest she may have to the said Emma Cumsey, and she further quitclaiming by her quit claim deed any title to the land hereinafter described.

And it further appearing to the court that the said Rosa Watushe is satisfied with the consideration herein named, and that she, for the purpose of transferring her interest to the said minor heir Emma Cumsey, has made a quit claim deed and filed her petition for the approval of the deed herein mentioned.

And it further appearing to the court that the said John Washington was the owner of the allotment described as follows:

The Northwest quarter of Section Ten, Township Eighteen North, Range Twelve, East, situated and lying in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

And it further appearing to the court that Rosa Watushe has executed the deed as aforesaid to the land above described.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the quit claim deed conveying all the right, title and interest of Rosa Watushe, which she has executed to Emma Cumsey, be and is hereby declared valid and is in all things ratified, approved and confirmed.
