RENTAL CONTRACT.

Made and executed this 7th day of pecember A.D. 1910, by and between May Fields, of Collinsvi le, Oklahoma, party of the first part, hereinefter called the lessor, and Brown & Ellingwood, of Collinsville, Oklahoma, parties of the second part, hereinafter called the lessees.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars (\$50.00) cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, as the first payment, on said rents provided, the lessor hereby rents to the lessees, their successors and assigns, the following described tract of land, situated in the county of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The west half ( $\mathbb{W}_{2}^{1}$ ) of Northeast quarter (NE<sub>4</sub>) of section twenty two (22) Township Twenty stwo (22) North range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing eighty acres more or less.

To have and to hold the said premises for agricultural and grazing purposes during the term of Three (3) years from January 1st, 1911, to January 1st, 1914, and the lessor hereby rents the same for the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) for the entire term of this lesse, payable in four (4) payments as follows: to-wit: Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) cash in hand, as above stated, Fifty dollars (\$50.00) on or before the 1st day of January 1911, One Hundred dollars (\$100.00) on or before the 1st day of January 1912; and One Hundred dollars (\$100.00) on or before the 1st day of January 1913.

The lessor hereby agrees that possession of the above described land shall be given to said second parties at once on this date, but if possession is not given as so stated then the rents are to commence from date of possession.

It is furher understood and agreed that all improvements placed on said lands by the said lessees, their heirs or assigns, may be removed by them at or before the expiration of this contract, and further that no contract other or different from this shall ever be claimed by either of the parties hereto unless the same is in writing and signed by each party hereto.
