Lot No. 158 in Block No. 14, of Tulsa Heights according to a map or plat thereof used by said Tulsa Heights Company and filed for record and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the United States Court and ex officio Recorder at Tulsa, Indian Territory, the same being a part of that portion of the West Half (W 1/2) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) and the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4) of section Twenty-Nine (29) Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East.
