DEED.

Witnesseth, the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of \$300 Three Hundred dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns all of the following described real estate, situated in the county of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma.

Lot Three (3) in block Four (4) of the Orcutt Addition to the City of Tulsa Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof.

This deed is subject to the condition and reservation binding upon the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that in no event shall the party of the second part, his heirs or assigns, erect upon the within premises a building to be used for residence purposes costing less than \$1000.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Orcutt Addition company for itself and its Successors and assigns does hereby covenant promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the deliver of these presents it is lawfully seized in its own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that <sup>same</sup> ~~there~~ are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances of what nature and kind/ever. and that it will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns against said party of the first part its successors and assigns and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
