QUIT CLAIM DEED

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One dollars to him duly paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged does hereby quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part-- of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever all his right, title interest and estate both at law and in equity of, in and to the following described real estate situate in the county of Tulsa, and state of Oklahoma, towit: The south one half of the north east quarter of section twenty three (23) Township Seventeen (17) north Range fourteen (14) east. This deed is given to correct one deed given by W.L. McAtee to Bluford Compton, dated Oct 12th 1910 recorded in Book 76 Page 232 of the records of Tulsa County Oklahoma, wherein the description read the south one half of the north west quarter of section 23, Township 17 North range 14 East when it should of been the south one half of the North east quarter of the same section together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging.
