To have and to hold the same unto the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, and to its successors and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with the said The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company that I will forever warrant and defend the title to said lots against all claims whatsoever.
