#### WARRANTY DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 20th day of January One thousand nine hundred and five by and between Josephine C. Rasmus and William F. Rasmus, of Tahlequah, I.T. parties of the first part, and The Atchison Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred twenty five Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate and premises, situated in the Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: All that part of the southeast quarter (1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of section fourteen (14) township twenty (20) north, range thirteen (13) East, lying within seventy five (75) feet on each side of the center line of said
