WARRANTY DEED.

DEED FILE NO. 15349 Return to Secretary the A.T. & S.F. Ry Co., Topeka,

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 23rd day of December, one thousand
nine hundred and four by and between Rachel C. Brady, and Wyatt T. Brady, her husnad
of Tulsa, I.T. parties of the first part, and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe
Railway Company, of--party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration
of the sum of two hundred fifty and No/100 dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said
party of the second part its successors and assigns the following described real estate
and premises situate in The Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Terri-
tory, to-wit: All that part of the North west quarter of section twenty two (22)
Township Twenty (20) north range thirteen (13) East lying northerly of a line one
hundred (100) feet distant from southerly of and parallel to the located center
line of said Railway Company's main track as the survey thereof is now located over
and across said quarter section containing six and 24/100 acres more or less. The
grantors herein retain title to the coal under the right of way hereby conveyed and
retain the right to mine the same in such a way and to such extent as will not
interfere with the proper construction and maintenance of said Railway company's tracks or
road bed
