TO THE CLERK OF THE UNITED STATES COURT FOR THE INDIAN TERRITORY; NORTHERN DISTRICT:

We the undersigned, heretofore appointed by the Honorable Joseph A. Gill, Judge of the United States Court for the Indian Territory, Northern District, to appraise the compensation and damages to be paid to the above named defendants and to all parties interested by reason of the appropriation and condemnation of land sought to be taken by the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company, as the successor in interest by judicial sale of the Kansas Oklahoma Central & Southwestern Railway Company, for right of way and other railroad purposes, on the line of its amended definite location between Owasso in the Cherokee Nation and Tulsa in the Creek Nation in said Indian
