

We further report that on the 6th day of February A.D. 1905, at 9 o'clock A.M. the undersigned Referees met at the time and place appointed in said notices, and that the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company appeared by J.B. Furry, its attorney, and that after further adjournments we again met on Feb. 27 at 10 A.M. at same place.

We further report that after hearing all the testimony offered by the parties interested, we together carefully inspected said land and proceeded to assess the compensation and damages to be paid to the above named defendants and to all persons interested therein and we find that the land above described is necessary to be appropriated by said Railway Company for right of way and other ^{railroad} purposes, and that the damage sustained by reason of the appropriation and condemnation of the above described land for the uses and purposes as above set forth, is as follows:

Value of land consisting of 2.88 acres	\$36.00
Value of improvements taken	\$5.00
Damage to remainder of land by reason of the taking of said land and constructing a road thereon	\$40.00
Total compensation and damages	\$81.00

We further find that the above described land has been allotted to the above named defendants, John E. Archer, as a citizen of the Cherokee Nation or Tribe of Indians, and that said John E. Archer is entitled to the full amount of the award hereby made and that no other person or persons have any interest in or to said land or in or to the award hereby made.

We further find that the costs and expenses of the condemnation and appraisal of said land are as follows:
