ASSIGNMENT OF AN OIL AND GAS LEASE.

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said The Paraffine Oil Company, the owner of an undivided one half interest in the above described lease hereby bargains, sells, transfers, assigns and conveys its right, title and interest in and to said lease, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, to Britton-Johnson Oil Company, a corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma.
