ASSIGNMENT.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 20th day of December, 1910, by and between Exchange National Bank, a corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Jolie Oil Company, a corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma and E.F. Blaise of Tulsa, Oklahoma, parties of the second part, WITNESSETH, That,

Whereas, by an assignment dated January 10, 1910, filed for record on January 25, 1910, and recorded in Book 74, page 349 in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma; said Jolie Oil Company conveyed to The Farmers National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, all of its right, title and interest in and to a certain oil and gas mining lease covering $S\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 21 North, Range 13 East, dated September 5, 1908, and executed by Julia Johnston, guardian of Jimmie B. Johnston, a minor, in favor of Bingo Oil Company, and,

Whereas, by an assignment dated December 17, 1909, filed for record January 15, 1910 and recorded in Book 74 page 216 in the office of the Register of Deeds within and for the county of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, said E.F. Blaise transferred all of his right, title and interest in and to the above described oil and gas mining lease, and,

Whereas, both of these assignments were made for the purpose of securing certain indebtedness of said Jolie Oil Company and E.F. Blaise to the said The Farmers National Bank, and,

Whereas, said Exchange National Bank, as successor and assignee of said The Farmers National Bank, now holds both of the above mentioned assignments by conveyance from The Farmers National Bank and E.F. Blaise respectively.

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations said Exchange National Bank hereby and by these presents assigns, transfers and conveys unto said Jolie Oil Company and E.F. Blaise, all of its right, title and interest in and to the said oil and gas mining lease so executed on the 5th day of December, 1908, by Julia Johnston, guardian of Jimmie B. Johnston, a minor, in favor of The Bingo Oil company and covering $S\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section Eight (8) Township Twenty-one (21) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, which said lease was later assigned to the said Jolie Oil Company.

To have and to hold unto the said Jolie Oil Company and E.F. Blaise, under the terms of said original lease.
