RELEASE.

WHEREAS, on the 30th day of July, 1909, Goodman G. Sharpe, of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, did execute, acknowledge and deliver to E.H. Sharpe, his heirs and assigns, all the right, title, interest and estate in and to the property above described, which I have or may be entitled to by virtue of said mortgage lien, and do hereby declare the same fully Released and Discharged from any and all liens created by virtue of said notes and mortgage lien mentioned herein
