compensation or reimbursement to which such trustee may be or have become justly entitled for any services actually rendered or exPenses incurred under this instrument; but any such trustee and his representatives shall at all times have a lien therefor upon all moneys, securities, and other trust Property herein mentioned.

And is further expressly understood and agreed t hat all the covenants, stipulations, Premises, and agreements herein catained by or on behalf of said comPany shall bid and be binding upon its successors and assigns, whether so expressed or not.

Seventeenth. If the railroad company shall welland truly Pay or cause to be Paid all bonds to be issued under or entitled to the Protection of this deed of trust and the coupons attached thereto at the times and in the manner therein specified, and shall well and truly keep and Pefform all the things herein required to be kept and Pefformed by it, according to the true intent and meaning of these Presents, then, and in that case, all property, rights, and intersts herey conveyed shall revert to it, and the estate, right, title, and interest of the said trustee aforesaid shall thereupon cease, determine and become void; otherwise the same shall be, continue, and remain in full force and virtue.
