It is understood that the person securing this right of way in behalf of the grantee is without authority to make any covenant or agreement in respect to the premises not expressed herein.

RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) dollars to the undersigned owners in hand paid by The Texas Company, a corporation of Texas, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged Rosa Washington Gibson joined by her husband John Gibson do hereby grant to the said The Texas Company, a corporation, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain operate, relay and remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas, and to erect, maintain and operate a telegraph or telephone line with right of ingress and egress to and from both, said right of way being ^{more} fully described by plats of definite location approved by the Secretary of the Interior, on, over, and through certain lands allotted to Rosa Washington a citizen of the Cherokee Nation, Roll No. 10284 situate in the county of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, and described as follows: The NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 24, Township 22 N. Range 12 E.

The said grantors their heirs or assigns are to fully use and enjoy the said premises except the easement for the purposes hereinbefore granted to The Texas company a corporation its successors and assigns.

The Texas Company, for itself and its successors or assigns hereby covenants to bury its lines of pipe so that the same will not interfere with the cultivation of said premises.

It is hereby further agreed that the Texas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay additional lines of pipe alongside of the first line, as herein provided for, upon payment of all additional damages, and subject to the same conditions
