#### ORDER AND DECREE CONFIRMING SALE.

This matter coming on to be heard on this 31st day of January, A. D. 1910, upon petition of Austin Chissoe praying for an order of this Court approving a certain deed by him executed conveying his inherited interest in and to the Northeast Quarter of section 13, township 17 north of range 14 east of the Indian Meridian;

The said petitioner appearing in person and by his attorney, W. S. Bailey, and the Court after hearing the testimony of the petitioner and disinterested witnesses and the argument of Counsel and being fully advised in the premises doth find:

That all the allegations contained in petitioners petition are true.

The Court further finds that said Elnora Chissoe was a mixed blood Creek Indian and was duly enrolled as such; that by reason thereof there was allotted to her the following described lands, situated in what is now Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Northeast quarter of section 13, township 17 north of range 14 east of the Indian Meridian.

The Court further finds that said Elnora Chissoe died on or about the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 1900, at the age of \_\_\_\_\_ years and in what is now Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma leaving as her sole and only heirs at law in whom title to said lands might, could or did vest, William Fulson and Taylor Chissoe, her sons, Sallie Chissoe and Dora Chissoe, her daughters and Austin Chissoe, her husband.

The Court further finds that on the 9th day of August, A. D., 1907, this petitioner made, executed and delivered a Warranty Deed to The August Land Company, a corporation, conveying all his right, title and interest in and to the Northeast quarter of section 13, township 17 north of range 14 east of the Indian Meridian for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration amounting in all to about Seven Hundred (\$700.00) Dollars and that said consideration is reasonable and just and equitable.

WHEREFORE, IT IS BY THE COURT CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said deed above described be, and the same is hereby approved according to the Act of Congress, Sec. 9, approved May 27, 1908 entitled "An Act for Removal of Restrictions from Part of the Lands of the Allottees of the Five Civilized Tribes and for other purposes".
