

And 2nd--to pay \$150 pollars per year for the gas from each and every gas well drilled on said premises; the product from which is marketed and used off the premises, said payments to be made on each well within sixty days after commencing to use the gas therefrom, as aforesaid, and to be paid yearly thereafter while the gas from said well is so used.

second party covenants and agrees to locate all wells so as to interfere as little as possible with the cultivated portions of the premises.

The party of the second part further agrees that in case no well is drilled for oil or gas within one year from the date hereof, all rights and obligations secured under this grant and demise shall cease upon three months notice in writing being served by the party of the first part, unless the party of the second part shall elect from year to year to continue this grant and demise in force as to any or all portions of the premises by paying in advance an annual rental of \$1.00 per acre for all of said land or such portion thereof as the party of the second part may designate, until a well is drilled, provided that, upon the completion of said well, the above provided for rentals shall cease. Such payments may be made direct to William Thompson or deposited to his credit in the first bank of Muskell, Okla.

IT IS AGREED that the second party is to have the privilege of using sufficient water from the premises to run all necessary machinery, and at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises; and, further, upon the payment of \$5.00 pollars at any time after giving three months notice by the party of the second part, his successors or assigns, to the party of the first part his heirs or assigns, said party of the second part, his successors or assigns, shall have the right to surrender this grant for cancellation, after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and determine, and this grant become absolutely null and void.
