COMPARED

RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars to the undersigned owners in hand paid by Oklahoma Pipe Line Company, a corporation of Oklahoma (assignee of The Prairie Oil and Gas Company, a corporation of Kansas), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Thomas Brown, a legal Guardian of person and estate of Henry Brown, minor, do hereby grant to the said Oklahoma Pipe Line Company, a corporation, its successors or assigns the right of way to lay, maintain, operate, relay and remove ^{a pipeline for the transportation of oil or gas, and erect, maintain and operate a telegraph or telephone line and agree to} right of ingress, to and from the same said right of way being more fully described by plats of definite location (made by said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company and now assigned to the Oklahoma Pipe Line Company), approved by the Secretary of the Interior on July 14, 1909, on, over and through certain lands allotted to Annie Rolland, a citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No., Situate in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, and described as follows: his undivided interest S. E. 4 of N. E. 4 Section 5, Township 16, Range 13, S 2 of N. E. of N. E. Section 5, Township 16, Range 13.

The said grantors, their heirs or assigns are to fully use and enjoy the said premises except the easement for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said Oklahoma Pipe Line Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns.

The said Oklahoma Pipe Line Company, a corporation, for itself and its successors or assigns hereby covenants to bury its lines of pipe so that the same will not interfere with the cultivation of said premises.

It is hereby further agreed that the said Oklahoma Pipe Line Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay additional lines of pipe alongside of the first line, as herein provided for, upon payment of all additional damages, and subject to the same conditions, provided assent and approved of the Secretary of the Interior be had therefor, if within the jurisdiction of such Secretary at that time.

It is hereby further agreed that the Oklahoma Pipe Line Company, its successors or assigns, shall have the right to change the size of its said line of pipe, the damage, if any, to crops and surface by reason of such change, to be paid by the said grantee, its successors or assigns.
