#### ORDER APPROVING LEASE.

And now on this 11th day of February, 1910, coming on to be heard the petition of William Thompson, as guardian of the above named minor, for the approval of an oil and gas mining Lease covering a portion of the allotment of the above named minor executed to E. R. Kemp, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for a bonus consideration of Two Hundred (\$200.00), and One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars per annum for each gas well from which gas is marketed off the premises, and the Court having fully examined said lease and finding that the same has been executed in compliance with the order of this Court, is of the opinion that the same should be approved.

It is therefore ordered, considered and adjudged, that the oil and gas mining lease executed to William Thompson, as guardian of Tobias Thompson, a minor, as lessor, to E. R. Kemp, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, as lessee, for a term to expire with the majority of said minor on March 1, 1926, covering a portion of the allotment of said minor described as follows, to-wit:

The South Half (S 1/2) of the South East Quarter (SE 1/4) of the North East Quarter (NE 1/4) of section Six (6) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Ten (10) East, be and the same is hereby confirmed, ratified and approved.
