WHEREAS, SELINA FIFE, nee HARJO, an allottee of the CREEK Nation, has made application for the removal of restrictions from the following described land, to-wit:

Lot Three (3) and Lot Four (4) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Eleven (11) East of the Indian Base and Meridian- containing 81.81 acres, more or less.
