be made to lessor or the then owner of said land; and changes in regulations thereafter made by the Secretary of the Interior applicable to bil and gas leases shall not apply to his lease.

13. Each and every clause and covenant of this indenture shall extend to the heirs executors, administrators, successors, and lawful assigns of the parties hereto. 14.
