ORDER FOR APPROVAL.

Now, on this 14th day of February, 1910, the above cause coming on for hearing upon the petition of Taylor Bear and Thomas Williams for the approval of a certain deed of even date herewith, to H. U. Bartlett of Mannford, Oklahoma, conveying the North Half of the North Half of Section Twenty-one (21) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Ten (10) East, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Twenty (\$320.⁰⁰) Dollars, now in possession of this Court:

And the Court having heard the said petition and having heard the evidence introduced by the said petitioners, and being fully advised in the premises, finds that Jennie Deerhead, enrolled on the Creek Indian Roll opposite No. 9989 as a full blood, died intestate, unmarried and without issue on or about the 9th day of February, 1903, near the town of Mellette, and what is now within the confines of McIntosh County, State of Oklahoma, and that at the time of her death she was seized of the following described land, to-wit:

The North Half of the North Half of Section 21, Township 19, North,
Range 10 East.

That her sole and only heirs at law surviving the said deceased were her father Taylor Bear and her half brother Thomas Williams, the petitioners herein;

That the Court finds that the mother of the said Jennie Deerhead died prior to her death without having other children born to her except the said Thomas Williams, the petitioner herein, and one Ben Cato, who died prior to the death of the said Jennie
