3. All the shares of stock and the certificates therefor bonds, corporate securities and evidences of indebtedness ^{now} ~~which may hereafter be acquired and owned by~~ the Company ~~and~~ which simultaneously with the execution of this mortgage or deed of trust are delivered by the Company to the Trustee.

4. All other shares of stock and the certificates therefor, bonds, corporate securities and evidences of indebtedness which may hereafter be acquired and owned by the Company and which as soon as so acquired and owned, shall be delivered to the Trustee. *As that certain piece or parcel of land*

5. Also all the following described pieces or parcels of land ^{*Situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma and described as follows*} in the Creek Nation, and being the west half of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter, and Lot Number Seven in Section Three, Township Nineteen North, Range Twelve east, and containing 26.49 acres, more or less, and being the same piece or parcel of land conveyed to J. M. Guffey by Rose Caesar et al., by deed dated June 16, 1904, and recorded at Sapulpa, Oklahoma, in Record G. at page 236.

Excepting and reserving therefrom that portion thereof condemned by the Tulsa Water Light & Power Company for water purposes only, such condemned portion being the east half of that part of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section Three, Township Nineteen, Range Twelve east, and designated as Lot Number Seven, which lies north of the Arkansas River, and contains 3.24 acres, more or less.

X (b) That certain other piece or parcel of land in the Creek nation, and being the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section Ten, Township Nineteen north, Range Thirteen east, and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter and Lot Number Five of Section Three, Township Nineteen North, Range Thirteen east, and Lot Number Seven of Section Two, Township Nineteen, north, Range Twelve east, and containing in all 137.77 acres, and being the same piece or parcel of land which was conveyed to John H. Gayley by deed from Rost Caesar et al., and recorded at Sapulpa, Oklahoma, in Record F at page 214.

Excepting and reserving from the piece or parcel of land last above described that portion thereof condemned by the Tulsa Water Light & Power Company for water purposes only, Such condemned portion being that part of Lot Number Seven, Section Two, Township Nineteen North, Range Twelve east, which lies between the Arkansas River and a line beginning at a point at the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section Two, and running thence diagonal diagonally to a point in the southeast corner of the said southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section Two, and containing 14.87 acres, more or less.
