

The petition of Louisa Delbrugge, filed in this Court on the 15th day of December, 1909, asking that a certain document filed on said date, purporting to be the last will and Testament of Louis Delbrugge, deceased, be admitted to probate as the last Will and Testament of the said Louis Delbrugge, deceased, and that Louisa Delbrugge, who is named therein as executrix, be appointed as such, and that Letters Testamentary be issued to the said Louisa Delbrugge, coming regularly on for hearing this 4th day of January, 1910, and due proof being made that notice has been duly given of the time appointed by this Court for proving said will and hearing said petition, and,

It appearing that notice of said hearing has been duly published in the Tulsa Democrat for three consecutive weeks, the first publication being made on the 16th day of December, 1909, and the last publication being made on the 30th day of December, 1909, and that said notice had been duly served upon all parties interested in said estate, according to law; and,

It further appearing that the said Louis Delbrugge died testate, in the County of Ohio, State of West Virginia, in the 2nd day of November, 1909; and,

It appearing by the duly authenticated copy of said will, and the probate thereof, that the said will has been proved, allowed and admitted to probate in another of the United States, to-wit: in the County of Ohio, State of West Virginia; and,

It further appearing to the Court that said Will was duly executed according to the laws of the State of West Virginia; and,

It further appearing that the personal property of the said estate, situated in the State of Oklahoma, is of the value of \$1000, and that the annual rental and profits from realty belonging to said estate, situated in the State of Oklahoma, amounts to \$1200;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that said will be and the same is hereby admitted to probate, and that Letters Testamentary be issued thereon to Louisa Delbrugge, the person named in said Will as executrix, without bond, the testator having so directed in his said will, and that said Letters Testamentary issue upon the taking of the oath of office by the said Louisa Delbrugge.
