WAIVER OF OBLIGATION UNDER BOND.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, whereas, on the 6th day of March 1908, the Secretary of the Interior approved an oil and gas mining lease on the allotment of Taylet Morgan, said allotment embracing the following described lands:

Southwest Quarter of Northeast quarter less 3.18 acres K. O. C. & S., R. R., right of way, and Southwest Quarter of Southeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter of Sec. 6, township 21 North, Range 14 E., containing 46.82 acres, more or less. said lease being date d July 27, 1907 and made by Taylet Morgan in favor of Duquesne Oil and Gas Company and,

WHEREAS, the said Duquesne Oil and Gas Company made and executed a bond to the United States of America in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) conditioned upon the said Duquesne Oil and Gas Company faithfully performing all the obligations and conditions of the aforesaid lease and observing all the laws of the United States and regulations thereunder made by the Secretary of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Interior has been relieved by Act of Congress of May 27, 1908, of all further jurisdiction of said premises and said lease and is desirous of being relieved of any and all obligations and duties assumed under said bond; and

WHEREAS, the said Taylet Morgan has transferred all his right, title and interest in and to said land to James D. Ward, said transfer having been made on the 10th day of October 1908, and said James D. Ward has transferred all his right, title and interest in and to the same to James M. Cobb said transfer having been made on the 11th day of January 1909,
