United States of America in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15000) conditional upon the said Duquesne Oil and Gas Company faithfully performing all the obligations and conditions of the aforesaid lease and observing all the laws of the United States and regulations thereunder made by the Secretary of the Deterior; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Interior has been relieved by Act of Congress of May 27, 1908, of all further jurisdiction of said premises and said lease and is destrous of being relieved of any and all obligations and duties assumed under said bond; and

WHEREAS, the said Annie E. White has transfered allher right, title and interest in and to said land to James D. Ward, said transfer having been made on the 5th day of & December 1908, and said James D. Ward has transfered all his right, title and interest in and title to the same to James M. Cobb said transfer having been made on the 11th day of January, 1909, and said James M. Cobb has transferred all his right, title and interest in same to L. J. Atwood said transfer having been made on the 31st day of January 1910.

NOW THEREFORE, I, L. J Atwood for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar (\$1.00) the receipt whereof is herebyacknowledged, do hereby relieve and release the United States of America from all further obligations and duties under said lease to Duquesne Oil and Gas Company and under said bond made by the United States Ffdelity and Guaranty Company, as surety; and

DO HEREBY SUBSTITUTE for the United States Indian Agent, Union Agency, Muskogee, Oklahoma, the Farmers and Merchants Bank of Collinsville, Oklahoma as a place of payment of the rentals and royalties under said lease, do hereby authorize the lessee and his assigns to pay all rentals and royalties falling due under said lease at the said Farmers and Merchants Bank, of Collinsville, Oklahoma, to the owner of the said land, and do hereby agree that all advance royalty and rental, payable for the delay of operations and the first puritally rayment in advance in first puritally rayment payable for the delay of operations, is paid.
