GENERAL WARRANTY DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 31 day of Oct, one thousand, nine hundred and six by and between Elmer R. Rolston and.....of Broken Arrow, party of the first part, and H. I. Kittsell and O. C. Brogg of Broken Arrow parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said parties of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit:—

The $W\frac{1}{2}$ of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $E\frac{1}{2}$ of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 18 north, Range 14 East of the Indian Base and Meridian Containing Thirty acres more more or less. Parties of Second part assume a certain note dated May 13/1905 for the sum (\$450.00) Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars in favor of J. L. Wheeler as a part of the purchase price of said land.
