CANCELLATION OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

WHEREAS the secretary of the Interior on July 28th 1908, approved an oil and gas mining lease, executed February 11, 1908, by and between John W. D. Langley, party of the first part, lessor, and the Decem Oil Company, a corporation of Bolivar, N. Y., and Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part, lessee, covering the lands described below, and

WHEREAS said lease has been removed from the jurisdiction of the Secretary of the Interior by Act of Congress approved May 27th, 1908, the lessor being of less than one-half Indian blood.

Langley, lessor, and the Decem Oil Company, lessee, do hereby mutually agree that from and after this date said lease shall be of no future force and effect and the lessee is hereby specifically relieved from all further obligations in connection with same and the bond filed in connection therewith.
