Order Confirming Oil and Gas Lease.

Now on this 15th day of March, 1910, this cause comes on to be heard upon the petition of Sampson Drew, guardian of Bob Glover and Johnny Glover, minors, for an order to approve an oil and gas lease made upon the lands of each of said minors.

The court having examined the petition, the leases and the proof tendered in support thereof finds that on the 15th day of March, 1910, the said guardian did enter into an oil and gas lease for the land of his ward Bob Glover, situated in Creek County, Oklahoma, described as Lot 2 and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and E $\frac{1}{2}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 6 township 17 north, range 11 East; and the lands of Johnny Glover, minor, described as lot 2, the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and N $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 1; lots 1 and 2 and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 2, all in twship 19 north, range 11 East, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma for 10 years or during the minority of said minor owning each of said tracts of lands, for a cash bonus of \$80, for a royalty of 1/
