ORDINANCE No. 608. 11/24.

An Ordinance providing for the vacation of a portion of the ally in Block 128, original town of the City of Tulsa, running back from Houston Avenue in said Block 140 feet.

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma:

Section 1. That that portion of the twenty (20) foot alley running west from Houston Avenue through Block 128 for a distance of 140 feet west ^{from said Houston Avenue} and lying between lots one (1) two (2) and three (3) in said Block and thus more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeasterly point of Lot two (2) running thence in a Westerly direction one hundred and forty (140) feet; thence in a Northerly direction twenty (20) feet; thence in an Easterly direction one hundred and forty (140) feet to said Houston Avenue; thence in a Southerly direction twenty (20) feet to the point of beginning, the same being the Easterly 140 feet of of said 20 feet alley in said Block 128, be and the same is hereby vacated, abandoned and closed to the public forever, and that said tract of land so vacated shall revert to the abutting lots in said Block as now laid out and described.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
