Creek Nation had allotted to her the above described lands; and it further appearing to the Court that the Baid Polly Beaver died in Hughes County where she then resided and left surviving her as her sole and only heirs at law her Father and Mother, the afore mentioned Party Beaver and Lucy Beaver; and it further appearing that the said Party Beaver and Lucy Beaver are full blood Indian citizens of the Creek Nation, and are of full age; and the Court being fully advised in the premises, finds:

That it has full and complete furisdiction of the parties hereto and the subject matter hereof; that the said Party Beaver and Lucy Beaver are the sole and only heirs of the Baid Polly Beaver, deceased; that the consideration paid for the said deed is adequate, and that the said Party Beaver and Lucy Beaver had good right to sell and convey said land at the time of the execution of said deed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED? CONSIDERED AND ADJUDGED, that under and by virtue of the power vested in this court by the provisions of Section 9 of the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, the said deed so executed as aforesaid, which is here now presented to the Court and is attached hereto, is in all things fully confirmed and approved.
