ORDER CONFIRMING LEASE.

And <sup>now</sup> on this 22nd day of March, 1910, this cause coming on for hearing and the Court being fully advised in the premises, the Court finds: That R. C. Fleming is the legally appointed, qualified and acting guardian of Sarah Myers, a minor; that the said Sarah Myers is a citizen of the Creek Nation, State of Oklahoma, and as such citizen has had allotted to her and now owns in fee simple the following described lands to-wit:

The Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty (20), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Ten (10) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, containing 160 acres more or less.

The Court further finds that said Sarah Myers is a minor of about the age of eight years and lives in Muskogee County, State of Oklahoma.

And it further appearing to the Court that under and in pursuance of an order of this Court regularly made and issued, the said R. C. Fleming, guardian of the aforementioned minor, did sell an oil and gas mining lease on the above described lands to Robert Oglesby, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and pursuant to such sale did execute a proper conveyance to said Robert Oglesby.

And it further appearing to the Court that the said Robert Oglesby has paid as a bonus for said oil and gas mining lease the sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty-five (\$1,725.00) dollars and has agreed in such conveyance to pay unto the said minor a royalty of Twelve and one-half (12 1/2) per cent of all oil produced and saved from said premises; and the sum of One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00) dollars per year for the gas from each well drilled on said premises that produces gas only, the product from which is marketed and used off the premises; the Court finds that said sum is a good and sufficient bonus for said conveyance and is as much as could be obtained and that the terms and conditions of said conveyance were just and for the best interest of said minor.

IT IS THEREFORE, Ordered, Adjudged, and Decreed by this Court that the act of the said Guardian in executing said Oil and Gas Mining Lease on the above described land to Robert Oglesby of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby in all things ratified, confirmed and approved.
