It is understood by and between the parties hereto that the terms of this lease shall extend to and be binding upon their heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns.

And I, Emma Gaulding, wife of said lessor, in consideration of the foregoing promises, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part, all my right of dower and homestead in and to the above described premises for the purposes of the foregoing lease.
