THE MUSKOGEE (CREEK) NATION INDIAN TERRITORY.

TO ALL, TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, a townsite commission, heretofore appointed and acting under authority of the Act of Congress approved March 1, 1901 (31 Stat. 861) agreement ratified by the Creek Nation May 25, 1901, has appraised the lots in the town of Tulsa, Muskogee (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory, and

WHEREAS, the plat of said town was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 11th day of April 1902 and was duly placed on file; and

WHEREAS, said commission has appraised all of the town lots included in said plat at their true value excluding improvements which appraisal has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, the said commission has awarded the real estate described hereinbelow to Nancy Littlejohn who has paid One Hundred <sup>Ten</sup> & No/100 (\$110.00) Dollars, the full amount of the purchase price into the treasury of the United States, to the credit of the Muskogee or Creek Nation of Indians, with the United States Indian Agent, at Muskogee Indian Territory, and is, therefore, entitled to a patent.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, do by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid Act of the Congress of the United States, hereby grant, sell, and convey unto the said Nancy Littlejohn heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title, and interest of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, aforesaid, in and to Lots Numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 in Block numbered 196 in the town of Tulsa, Muskogee (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory, and according to the plat there of on file as aforesaid.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said nation to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown.
