TAX DEED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, whereas, the following described property to-wit: Lot six, Block Twenty five situated in the town of Skiatook, county of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, which was prior to Nov. 16th 1907, in the Northern District of the Indian Territory, was subject to taxation for the year A.D. 1907.

And, whereas, the taxes assessed upon said real property for the year aforesaid, remained due and unpaid at the date of the sale hereinafter mentioned:

And, whereas, the collector of the revenue of said town of Skiatook, then known as the tax collector, did, on the 13th day of April 1908 by virtue of the authority in him vested by law, at the sale begun and publicly held on the 13th day of April A.D. 1908, expose to public sale at the office of said tax collector in said town of Skiatook, in substantial conformity with all the requirements of the statutes in such cases made and provided, the real property above described for the payment of the taxes, penalties, and costs then due and remaining unpaid on said property.

And, whereas, at the time and place aforesaid, Carrie V. Tyler of the town of Skiatook, in the Northern District of the Indian Territory, now in the county of Tulsa, and state of Oklahoma, having offered to pay the sum of \$2.14 two dollars and fourteen cents, being the whole amount of taxes, penalties, and costs then remaining due and unpaid on said property for, ^{the lot Block Twenty five which was the least quantity bid for} and payment having been by her made to said tax collector of said town of Skiatook as aforesaid, said property was stricken off to her at that price.
