## TRUSTEE'S DEED

WITNESSETH, the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of (\$350) Three hundred and fifty dollars in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part his heirs, executors administrators and assigns, the following described real property and premises, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot (5) five in Block (49) Forty nine of the Townsite of Tanaha, according to a plat thereof, duly filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on September 23, 1909.

To have and to hold the same, together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging and the said party of the first part, for and on behalf of said Tanaha Townsite Company, but not individually, hereby warrants the title to the same.

To have and to hold said above described premises unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgments, mortgages and other liens and incumbrances of whatsoever nature, except the right to drill for oil and gas purposes.
