This agreement, made and entered into by and between Alonzo Ward, party of the first part, and C.R. Hunter and Richard Burkhart, parties of the second part, as follows:

WITNESSETH, The said Alonzo Ward agrees to give the parties of the second part exclusive sale of the south half of the N.W. quarter of section 33, twp. 21 north, range 13 east, for the sum of four thousand dollars, it being understood that said sum shall not include the four thousand dollars royalty for oil now in the First National Bank, of Tulsa, Okla., but shall include all royalty subsequently accruing to the holder of said allotment, said parties of the second part to have as their commission all sums over four thousand dollars and the royalty referred to in the First National Bank.

If any further sum that the holder of said premises secures above the amount of four thousand dollars which the holder of said allotment may secure as damages, shall go to parties of second part.

This option is given for the period of thirty days from this date the consideration for same being one dollar and other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.
