ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR

Whereas, David McHodge an allottee of the Creek Nation, has made application for the removal of restrictions from the following described land, to-wit:

The southeast quarter (SE/4) of the Southwest quarter (SW/4) of Section Six (6) Township Nineteen (19) North, range thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 40 acres more or less.

Now Therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, (Public No. 140) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said above described land without conditions concerning terms of sale and disposal of the proceeds; said removal of restrictions to be effective thirty days from date hereof.
