( Order of Confirmation and Approval of Oil and Gas Lease.

This cause coming on to be heard this 14 day of March, 1910, upon the petition of John M. Taylor for power to lease the following described lands of Floyd Riley, his ward, and for the confirmation of an Oil and Gas Lease executed, March 14, 1910, to Walter L. Ransom, of Sapulpa Oklahoma, upon the following described lands.

Lots 1, 2 and 3, and the South W. Quarter of the N.E. Quarter of Sec. 3, Twp 19 N. Range 11 east of the Indian Meridian and Lot 2 and the south east quarter of the North west quarter of Sec. 4, Twp. 19 N.
