This deed of release made this the 14th day of May, 1910, by and between J.A. McCullough, party of the first part and P.M. Kerr and Eva B. Kerr, his wife, O.M. Lancaster and Mae Lancaster, his wife of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, parties of the second part, WITNESSETH:

That whereas on June the 30th 1909, the said parties of the second part executed to the party of the first part their promissory note, dated June the 30th, 1909, for the sum of Eleven Thousand (\$11000.00) dollars due one year after date, negotiable and payable at the Farmers' National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and bearing interest from date at the rate of 8 per cent per annum; and whereas on said June the 30th, 1909, said parties of the second part, in order to secure the payment of said note and interest signed, executed and acknowledged a mortgage to the party of the first part, wherein and whereby, for the purposes aforesaid they conveyed to said party of the first part the following described real estate situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Number three (3) Block Number one hundred and seven (107) in the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the United States Government Survey, and whereas said mortgage was duly recorded in the office of the Register of deeds on June the 30th 1909, in record 63 page 104, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and whereas said parties of the second part have paid in full said above described note for eleven Thousand (\$11000.00) dollars, and all interest thereon from June the 30th 1909 to June the 30th, 1910.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the payment of said note and interest as aforesaid, the said party of the first part does hereby release, cancel and discharge the aforesaid mortgage, and does hereby quit claim and convey to the parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns all of his interest, in and title to the above described property, and said mortgage is hereby declared to be satisfied in full and forever discharged.
