## AFFIDAVIT

I, Lee Clinton, after being first duly sworn, state on oath that I am the father of Celia Clinton to whom was allotted, as a portion of her surplus allotment, the East Half of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section Fourteen (14) Township Nineteen (19) North, range twelve (12) East in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, less Five One Hundredths (05) of an acre occupied as right of way of the St L and S. F. R.R. Co. Said land, comprising Thirty Nine and 95/100 Acres, was duly conveyed to the said Celia Clinton by allotment deed duly approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 27th, 1903, which deed was duly filed for record in the office of the Commissioner to the Five Civilized Tribes at Muskogee, Oklahoma, on February 4th, 1903.

I further state that the said Celia Clinton died in infancy, on the date of February 2nd, 1904, in her fifth year; and that she left her surviving as her next of kin the following persons to-wit:

1. Her father, Lee Clinton, a duly enrolled citizen of the Creek Nation.
  2. Her mother, Susan M. Clinton, a non-citizen of the Creek Nation.
  3. Her brother, Walton Spence Clinton, a duly enrolled citizen of the Creek Nation
- all of whom are now living.

Inasmuch as my said daughter, Celia Clinton, died intestate and without heirs of her body, and inasmuch as her mother is a non citizen of the Creek Nation, I inherited an estate in fee simple absolute in the entire allotment of my said daughter, as is determined by the decision of the United States Circuit Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit in the case of Shulthis vs McDougal and others which is reported in 170 Federal Reporter, p.529. Since her death I have had the exclusive possession of the lands allotted to her and I am now in the exclusive possession of same with the exception of such portions thereof heretofore sold and conveyed by me to other persons.

I further state on oath that there are no judgments against me in the State of Oklahoma or elsewhere nor any judgments or legal proceedings affecting the title to said lands in any of the courts or Oklahoma or elsewhere.

ASSIGNMENT AND TRANSFER  
INTEREST IN AN OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, whereas, on April 28, 1908, certain oil and gas Mining Leases were executed by Gus Leverett, as Guardian one for William Sheridan Leverett, a minor, and one for Joe Leverett, a minor, lessor, to M.F.
