

The south east quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section three (3) Township Nineteen (19) North Range eleven (11) East and the South west quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section four (4) Township Nineteen (19) North, range Eleven (11) East, all in said Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and,

Whereas, said leases were first recorded in Volume 40 on pages 352 and 356 respectively, and afterwards, to wit On February 8, 1910, again filed for record with an assignment by said M.F. Steil to G.C. Hughes, to each said lease affixed and appended and made a part of the record, that subsequently said leases were assigned, by said G.C. Hughes otherwise, known and signing as Gordon C. Hughes, to the Fife Oil and Gas Company, a corporation, that said Fife Oil and Gas Company assigned interest in said leases as shown by assignments filed and made a matter of record on February 8, 1910 to Earle T. Miller, transferring their said interest in that portion of the land described in said leases, as follows, to-wit:

The west half of the Southwest quarter (W  $\frac{1}{2}$  of S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the South east quarter of the South west quarter (S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section Four (4) and the South west quarter of the South east quarter (S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section three (3) all in Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Eleven (11) East in said Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable considerations, the receipt whereof are hereby acknowledged, I, the said Earle T. Miller assignee, in the above described lease hereby bargains, sells, transfers, assigns and conveys an undivided one half interest in and to all my right title and interest acquired as such assignee in and to said lease, subject to all the conditions in said lease or in subsequent assignments made, to Frank S. Foster of Tulsa, Oklahoma, his executors, administrators or assigns.

And the said Frank S. Foster, as a further consideration for his interest therein accepts the conditions <sup>obligations</sup> in said lease and the agreements subsequently made in said assignment last named.
